## PUBLIC TELEPHONE

Most public telephones in Korea are coin-operated. A 3-minute call requires 70 KRW in coins. Emergency calls are free (e.g., 112 for police or 119 for fire or other emergencies). For international calls, a prepaid international telephone card is cheaper. Price and method of use for prepaid cards depend on the card type.

## TRANSPORTATION

City and intercity buses are the main transportation means to travel around the island. Taxis are also available. There are no subways or trains on Jeju. Individual travelers increasingly prefer to rent a car. Car rental operators are widely available around Jeju International Airport and Jeju International Ferry Terminal. For a reasonable price, you can rent a car with a navigation system to conveniently find places on Jeju. July and August are the high season and the price to rent a car is much higher due to high seasonal demand. If you are a foreign citizen, you need to show your international driver's license and passport to rent a car.

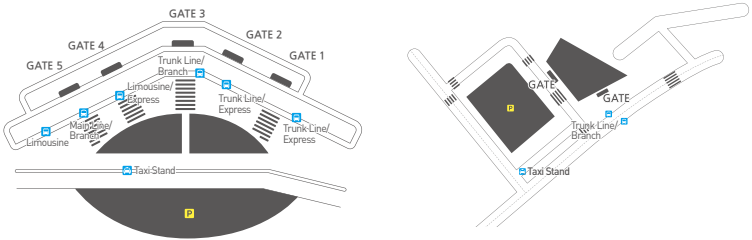

## T-money



T-money is a rechargeable card or “smart” device used to pay transportation fares in Korea. With T-money, you can conveniently use all types of buses on Jeju. T-money comes in the form of a card or keychain. If you’re a first-time user, you must purchase a card or keychain (non-refundable) and charge it with a desired amount at any shop where the T-money logo is displayed. Such shops can be easily found around the island. When you get on the bus, scan the T-money card or device at the card reader located next to the bus driver. The reader will deduct the appropriate fare from your card. Money remaining on your card can be refunded at any shop displaying the T-money logo.

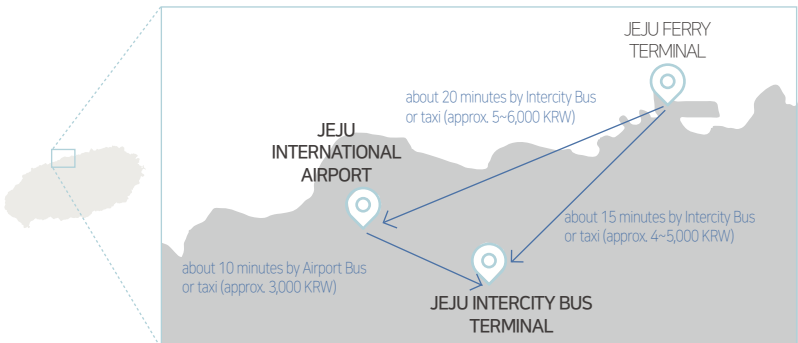

Jeju Island is located southwest of the Korean peninsula. It has been designated as Jeju Special Self-Governing Province. It is the Republic of Korea's largest island. A world-famous volcanic island with more than 90 percent of its total area covered with basalt. It is a strategically located island connects continental nations (Russia and China) to island nations (Japan and Southeast Asia). It is a resort island with magnificent views of nature.

Jeju is an oval-shaped island that is 73 km from east to west and 31 km from north to south, with Hallasan Mountain the center. The island has a coastal ring road of 176 km and 530.09 km of coastline. It has a temperate climate with temperatures that rarely drop below zero degrees.

It is home to 77 types of mammals, 198 species of birds, 8 kinds each of reptiles and amphibians, 873 types of insects and 74 varieties of spiders. The island, with Hallasan Mountain at its center, has recorded a total of 2,001 types of vertically distributed sub-tropical, temperate, and polar vegetation, in comparison with Baekdusan Mountain, which has about 500 types, and Jirisan Mountain, which has about 1,000.

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# UNESCO TRIPLE CROWN JEJU

Having won UNESCO-accredited titles such as a Biosphere Reserve, World Natural Heritage, and Global Geopark, Jeju is a world-renowned treasure island worthy of worldwide attention and conservation.

## UNESCO Biosphere Reserve (2002)

It includes Hallasan Mountain National Park, natural monuments such as Yeongcheon Stream and Hyodoncheon Stream, and Munseom Islet, Beomseom Islet, and Seopseom Islet.

## UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site (2007)

It includes Hallasan Mountain Nature Reserve, Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak, Geomun Oreum Lava Tube System (Geomun Oreum, Bangdwigul Cave, Manjanggul Cave, Gimnyeonggul Cave, Dangcheomul Cave, Yongcheon Cave, etc).

## UNESCO Global Geopark Network (2010)

It covers the entire region of Jeju, including Hallasan Mountain, Manjanggul Cave, Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak, Seogwipo Formation, Cheonjiyeon Falls, Jusangjeoli Columnar Joints in Jungmun and Daepo, Sangbansan Mountain, Yongmeori Tuff Ring, Suweolbong Peak, Udo Island, Biyangdo Island, Seonheul Gotzawal Forest (Dongbaek Dongsan).

## Yongnuni Parasitic Cone

Yongnuni Parasitic Cone is the main character which has made the term 'oreum (parasitic cone)' familiar to tourists who visit Jeju. Several movies and TV dramas such as <A Werewolf Boy>, <Goddess of Marriage>, <The Return of Superman> were filmed here. Yongnuni Parasitic Cone has well-paved paths and a gentle slope, so both young and old tourists can enjoy hiking. Even strolling will take only 20-25 minutes. The soft flowing curvy beauty while walking along the ridge will comfort your mind. Sporadic high winds may make walking difficult but it will feel somewhat refreshing. Tourists can see horses up close owing to their preference to graze freely on the nearby ranches.

**Tip** Do not approach horses too closely. If horses are blocking the path, slowly walk to the side and take a side path.

**Address** San 28, Jongdal-ri, Gujwa-eup, Jeju-si, Jeju-do **Level of difficulty** Easy

**Duration** Approx. 1 hour (Roundtrip)



## Ttarabi Parasitic Cone

Ttarabi Parasitic Cone is one of many silver grassy tourist sites that represent the east part of Jeju in autumn. Owing to its elegant beautiful scenery, it has a nickname 'the Queen of Parasitic Cone.' While walking along the trail, visitors will experience excitement and joy as if standing on a red carpet. The sparkling silver grass densely blossoming along the shoulder of the trail presents a splendid lower path as if being shone with a spotlight. On the peak, another scenic view is waiting. A wide field and a colony of several parasitic cones forming a folding screen along the horizon resemble a beautiful painting. Ttarabi Parasitic Cone has three craters, and the overlapping appearance provides a mystical mood.

**Tip** Public transportation is not available. The distance between the trail and the entrance of parasitic cone is lengthy.

**Address** San 62, Gasi-ri, Pyoseon-myeon, Seogwiposi Jeju-do **Level of difficulty** Easy to medium

**Duration** Approx. 1 hour (Roundtrip)





## Sara Parasitic Cone

Sara Parasitic Cone at the foot of Hallasan Mountain is a mystical geographic feature, embracing Sanjeong Lake. There are a few other parasitic cones with a crater lake, but Sara Parasitic Cone is located at the highest location in Jeju. The scenic view of the clear lake on the top of the mountain looks truly exotic. One regretful thing is that the lake is relatively shallow, so it often reveals its bottom on dry days. Fortunately, the dry lake also shows gradated mystical scenery with iridescent colors, so visitors can feel rewarded after a hike. A trail deck is constructed around the lake. After walking the stairs, visitors will be able to see the peak of Hallasan Mountain and beautiful scenery below.

**Tip** On the day following after a lot of rain, visitors can see the lake filled with water.

**Address** San 2-1, Sillye-ri, Namwoneup, Seogwipo-si, Jeju-do **Level of difficulty** Hard

**Duration** Approx 4 ~ 4 hours 30 min (Roundtrip)



## Baegyagi Parasitic Cone

This parasitic cone is covered with green grass and 100 kinds of herbal plants are growing, so it is named as Baegyagi (meaning 100 herbal plants). As the name implies, visitors can see various species of wild flowers and grass flowers. The extensive eadow relaxes our mind. The flat forest and the trail path paved with a strong wooden support make walking easy and they also serve as a good background for snapshots or wedding photos. Once getting to the peak, the soft breeze and warm sunlight welcome visitors. One might be tempted to lie in the grass and read a book or take a nap. Simply imagining an autumn picnic will bring a smile to your face.

**Tip** Geumbaekjo Trail which passes in front of the parasitic cone is famous for its silver

grass. Enjoy a drive after visiting the parasitic cone.

**Address** San 1, Seongeup-ri, Pyoseon-myeon, Seogwipo-si, Jeju-do

**Level of difficulty** Easy to medium **Duration** Approx. 1 hour 30 min (Roundtrip)



## Nokkome Parasitic Cone

Nokkome Parasitic Cone is the best among a group of parasitic cones formed at the foot of southern part of Hallasan Mountain. It consists of Keunnokkome (big) and Jogeunnokkome (small) Parasitic Cones in which the Keunnokkome Parasitic Cone has several steep sections, so it is not easy to hike, but you can take a leisurely hike to appreciate the unique scenery of a thick forest and Jeju broad-leaf bamboo. In particular, the parasitic cone boasts its excellent scenic view of silver grass colony formed along the ridge leading to the peak in autumn. Jogeunnokkome Parasitic Cone which is located on the back side of Keunnokkome Parasitic Cone is relatively small and easy to hike due to its gentle slope. However, the access road to the entrance of the parasitic cone is quite long and not many people visit it. The area is not usually accessed by many people, and still has thorny bushes and a primitive natural forest, providing attractive scenery.

**Tip** On the path, there is a forked path leading to Jogeunnokkome Parasitic Cone. However, after visiting Jogeunnokkome, you need to go back to the forked path.

**Address** San 138, Yusuam-ri, Aewol-eup, Jeju-si, Jeju-do **Level of difficulty** Easy to Hard

**Duration** Approx. 1 hour 30 min (Roundtrip)



## Saebyeol Parasitic Cone

Saebyeol Parasitic Cone is a representative parasitic cone in the west of Jeju that is frequently visited during the spring and autumn seasons. In spring, it holds the 'Jeju Field-Burning Festival' which is the largest festival in Jeju. After the fire burns in the parasitic cone with a message of hope for the year, plants start to sprout from a heap of black ashes. Silver grass grows busily during the hot summer and starts to blossom silver flowers, densely covering the entire parasitic cone. When sunlight shines brightly, the silver grass throughout the field looks like a snowfield in autumn. Through the beautiful scenery of little grass flowers, we can realize the mystery of life.

**Tip** If hiking up to the peak is difficult, use the opposite hiking trail to enjoy the silver grass

at the bottom of the parasitic cone.

**Address** San 59-8, Bongseong-ri, Aewol-eup, Jeju-si, Jeju-do **Level of difficulty** Medium **Duration** Approx. 1 hour (Roundtrip)



## Geumoreum (Geumak) Parasitic Cone

Geumoreum Parasitic Cone has become popular as it recently appeared in a music video of singer Lee Hyori. In the video, a small mystical pond in the crater received a lot of attention, but the scenery is hard to see except after a rainy day. However, even without the pond, visitors can enjoy a heart-throbbing view of majestic Hallasan Mountain and Biyangbong Peak on the blue sea. In addition, you can see paragliders embroidering the sky. Despite the beautiful scenery, the parasitic cone has a painful history. At Geumoreum Parasitic Cone, there are several tunnel fortifications made by the Japanese army during the Japanese occupation of Korea. During Jeju April 3 Incident, they were used as a shelter for residents

**Tip** The parking lot is small, so when you visit on holidays or weekends, be sure to depart in the early morning.

**Address** San 1-1, Geumak-ri, Hallim-eup, Jeju-si, Jeju-do **Level of difficulty** Medium

**Duration** Approx. 1 hour (Roundtrip)



## Jimi Parasitic Cone (Jimibong Peak)

Jongdal-ri is a small fishery village on the east seaside. In the village, you can find Jimi Parasitic Cone that offers the hidden mystical scenery of Seongsan Ilchulbong Tuff Cone and Udo Island. Even though you will need to overcome some difficult time of walking up the steep stairs that seem to continue endlessly, amazing scenery will await you once you get to the peak. The mystical appearance of Seongsan Ilchulbong Tuff Cone on the blue sea and Udo will reward you at the end of your sweaty hike. Furthermore, you can enjoy the panoramic view of Udo. If you walk to the opposite side, the scenic view of the colorful village will grab your attention. The densely clustered houses huddling together will give an impression of seeing a familiar farming village.

**Tip** Jimi Parasitic Cone is one of several tourist attractions of the Olle Trail 27 Course. If you cannot easily find the parasitic cone hiking trail, look for the Olle Trail Sign nearby.

**Address** San 3-1, Jongdal-ri, Gujwa-eup, Jeju-si, Jeju-do

**Level of difficulty** Medium to hard **Duration** Approx. 1 hour 30 min (Round trip)

## Black Pork

Many tourists, on the first time on Jeju, wonder where the best place is to try the island's delicious black pork. Sometimes, if you go by travel book recommendation it feels that something is missing and if you go to a totally unknown restaurant, you cannot be assured of the taste. In this situation, if you want a clear reply, the answer would be to "just go anywhere." Wherever you go on Jeju, you can find delicious black pork restaurants. The meat is even more delicious if you eat it with Mel-jeot, which is a salted anchovy that reduces the pork's oiliness and makes it tastier.

## Pheasant Cuisine

Since there are many pheasants on Jeju Island, there are many different dishes made using the bird. In the fall, pheasant is regarded as a real treat and can be eaten raw or dried as jerky. Kkwong-toryeom is a delicacy of thinly sliced pheasant breast meat that is eaten hot-pot style. Kkwong-memil guksu, (pheasant buckwheat noodles) delicately blends Jeju's buckwheat and pheasant meat. The buckwheat noodles are light and more digestible than other foods made with wheat. Pheasant dumpling soup is not greasy and its taste is sure to please.

## Horse Cuisine

Dishes made using horse were the finest served to the King in times of antiquity. Horse is used in a variety of dishes, including raw horse meat, horse sushi, tangsuyuk (sweet and sour meat), galbijjim (rib stew), gui (roast meat) and bulgogi (sliced and seasoned barbecued meat). Horse meat tastes lighter than beef and each part and organ, such as the liver, has its own unique flavor.

## Meat Noodles

The most common delicacy on Jeju is Gogi-guksu (Meat Noodles). After stewing a broth, add noodles and boiled meat and then add chilies, chili powder, pepper and other seasonings according to your taste. One plate of gogi noodles is enough for each person as it contains thick noodles with boiled meat. It is a good hangover soup, but also goes well with alcohol. If you want a cup of soju while eating the spicy soup, Jeju's Hallasan Soju it is the best complement.



## Seongkae-guk (Sea Urchin Soup)

Seongkae-guk (sea urchin soup) is prepared by frying seaweed in sesame oil and then putting sea urchin and obunjagi together and boiling them. If you salt it, it looks little yellowish and coagulates like tofu and tastes fresh. Seongkae is also known as gusal in Jeju so the dish is known as gusal-guk in some places.

## Dom-hoe

Yellow sea bream, one of the common fish on Jeju Island, is cheap but prides excellent taste. Since it is rare in land-based areas, try to taste it. More premium fish than the yellow sea bream is the sea bream, which is called the king of raw fish. The best taste of sea bream can be enjoyed during December until March. The best season of red tilefish is roughly during the start of spring while the soft and savory cuttlefish is loved during summer from June to August. Also, the best season of yellowtail is after October when cold wind blows and the taste of large-scale blackfish is at its best between December and March. These fish are must-try delicacies in Jeju.

## Mul-hoe (Raw Fish Soup)

A favorite delicacy of summer on Jeju is mul-hoe. It is called mul-hoe as it is prepared by pouring water and spices over fresh raw fish. There are many varieties such as jari-mul-hoe, sea cucumber mul-hoe, turban shell mul-hoe and mitra squid mul-hoe. All the ingredients are fresh so just pick the one that you like best. To prepare, cut vegetables such as parsley, pears, cucumbers, sesame leaves, green pepper and carrots into thin slices, season them with spiced seafood and pour water with ice over them all. The role of the ice is to make the soup cold and keep the seafood and vegetables fresh. After eating all the seafood, adding rice to the leftover soup makes another delicacy.

## Galchi (Hairtail) Cuisine

How best to eat Jeju's chubby and tasty galchi? The first choice is to eat it fresh as hoe (raw fish). Some people think that galchi-hoe has a fishy smell, but that is not true. It is tasty to chew and famous for its aroma. Another delight is boiled galchi in soy sauce and this is also liked by many. It is delicious if you melt raw galchi in your mouth slowly along with rice, or eat boiled galchi spiced with hot Jeju chili powder.

## Godeungeo (Mackerel)

Godeungeo, along with galchi, is one of the most loved fish types in the country. The full-fleshed fish makes your mouth water in anticipation. Godeungeo is inexpensive, full of nutrients and has an especially aromatic taste. After the breeding season finishes in summer, the fish gains more flesh and oil, thus autumn is the best time to eat it.

### Obunjagi Ttukbaegi (Seafood Soup)

The best seafood delight on Jeju Island is Obunjagi Seafood Soup. Obunjagi is a mollusk and a close relative of the abalone family. It lives clinging to rocks about 20 meters under the water. Around 70 percent of the total obunjagi found in Korea is from Jeju. The meat is full of calcium, iron and vitamin B. It can be roasted or put in doenjang soup or porridge, but the most highly recommended option is Obunjagi Seafood Soup. If you make rice using obunjagi, the rice will turn greenish. If you put butter at the edges of an earthen pot and add rice, the butter mixes with the rice making it more aromatic. If you include obunjagi with other seafood in doenjang soup, the taste will double. After eating, you can take the shells home for interior decorations.

### Jeon-bok (Abalone)

Jeon-bok (abalone) is so nutritious that it is also known as the wild ginseng of the sea. Many abalones are gathered from Jeju waters and it can be found in many delicacies. It is usually added to jeon-bok-hoe, juk (porridge), ttukbaegi, samgyetang (chicken soup with ginseng), and various other stews. Due to its quality and taste, abalone was offered to kings in olden times. Chajeon-bok is readily available on Jeju, as is obunjagi, which is another kind of Jeon-bok.

### Sora (Turban Shell)

Another common delicacy in seafood-rich Jeju is the sora (turban shell or conch). Therefore Jeju's sora is also known as the Tangerine of the Sea. Small hwalsora, which are also known as Gu-jeng-ki in Jeju, are hard and firm and the texture is like chewing Jeon-bok. Broiled sora roasted with its shell, sora-mul-hoe, jeot-kal and porridge made of sora are full of nutrients. The most common way to eat sora is to simply rinse it with sea water, cut it into thin slices and eat it with red chili-pepper paste and vinegar.

### Jarijeot

Jarijeot is a type of salt-preserved fish. The main ingredient, jaridom, is only caught in the seas near Jeju. Its taste is savory and it is good to eat once you remove its scales. Many people enjoy jarijeot because of its unique smell. It is seasoned with green peppers and garlic and served as a side-dish with rice. Some fish and a bowl of rice can be a generous meal.

### Meljeot (Myeolchijeot)

Myeolchijeot is made from raw anchovies salted in spring and fall. There are a variety of methods of



-serving it but its taste is guaranteed even without meat and eaten with rice wrapped in fresh lettuce or sesame leaves. In particular, it is good to refresh your sense of taste and supplement your energy after sweating in the middle of summer.

### Kkotmyeolchijeot

Kkotmyeolchi are often caught in the seas near Jeju and it is reddish brown unlike other myeolchijeot, it is characterized by its lightly fermented flesh, even after ripening long time. It tastes good and is tender and chewy due to its lack of bones.

### Gingyijuk(Rice Porridge with Crab)

Gingyi means crab in the Jeju dialect. Gingyijuk is a delicacy in May. The soup is made by pounding a crab in a stone mortar and adding water to make a thick crab juice and then straining it. It is then boiled slowly and crab juice is added and stirred in after stir-frying rice with sesame oil thoroughly. You can add salt according to your preference. It has abundant calcium which is good for bones and chitosan.

### Mungejuk (Rice Porridge with Octopus)

Munge means octopus in the Jeju dialect and refers to the common octopus (*octopus vulgaris*). Jeju's octopus is served raw or as part of a seasoned porridge.

Mungejuk is healthy food for ordinary people. The octopus is cut to remove its organs and is pounded in a mortar and fried with rice and sesame oil and then boiled after adding water.

When you pound the octopus in a mortar without cutting it with a knife, it becomes chewy and softer as the red color comes out of the skin.

### Jogaejuk (Rice Porridge with Clams)

Jogaejuk does not require other side-dishes due to its tasty, light and pleasant aftertaste. Summer is the perfect time to enjoy this dish due to plump clams tasting the best during this season.

### Bingddeok (Buckwheat Rice Cake)

Bingddeok is named after the shape of the ddeok after it is rolled. Fine buckwheat powder is made into a dough, which is fried in a thin round shape. Then radishes, carrots, green onions, salt, sesame power, sesame oil and other ingredients are used to make a filling, which is placed on the fried pancake and rolled up.



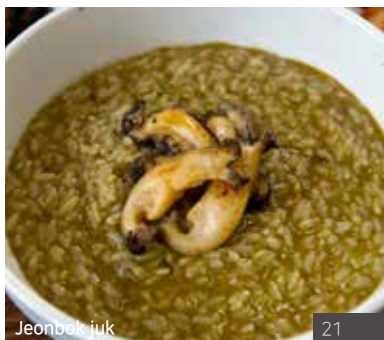

The Gwaneumsa Trail is noted as the most demanding course in Hallasan Mountain due to its dramatically shifting topography within the 9km course. Because it requires about 30 percent more physical strength than the other hiking trails, more professional climbers choose this trail. Nevertheless, people who have climbed Gwaneumsa once persist in climbing this trail if only because of the magnificent scenery it offers on Hallasan Mountain.

The Yeongsil Trail is relatively easy as it is the shortest course up Hallasan Mountain. It is open only up to Witse Oreum and does not allow hikers to reach Baengnokdam, the crater lake at the peak of Hallasan Mountain. Because of its relative ease, it is suitable for elderly climbers and newlywed couples on honeymoon and offers views of both Yeongsilgiam and Seonjakjiwat.

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## Scuba Diving *Dive into the blue sea*

The areas around Munseom(Mosquito Islet) and Beomseom(Tiger Islet) are perfect places to enjoy scuba diving because the sea maintains a temperature of 20 degrees year-round and there are beautiful underwater views.

**Note** Anyone can participate easily because swimming skills don't matter.

## Submarine *Abyss tour*

Exploring the sea of Jeju by submarine is the only way to see shipwrecks and the scenery 40 meters under the sea as well. This course should not be missed, as the underwater photography of this volcanic island's scenic seabed will be the most memorable.

**Note** Take seasick medicine if needed.

## Horseback Riding *Ride through the open fields*

To travel the large meadows of Jeju freely, horse-riding is highly recommended. Feeling the wind while on horseback gives you another typical taste of Jeju.

**Note** Be careful not to stand behind the horse not to be kicked.

## Paragliding *Be reborn as a human bird*

Experience the thrill of flying like a bird over Jeju's many hills with the cool wind blowing.

**Note** Be sure to wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants.

In addition to the above, there are also high-speed jet boats, relaxing yachts, parasailing, ATVS and karts. You can also enjoy hunting during the four months from November 1 through February.

## NOODLE STREET



### Jeju's Unique Noodle Dishes

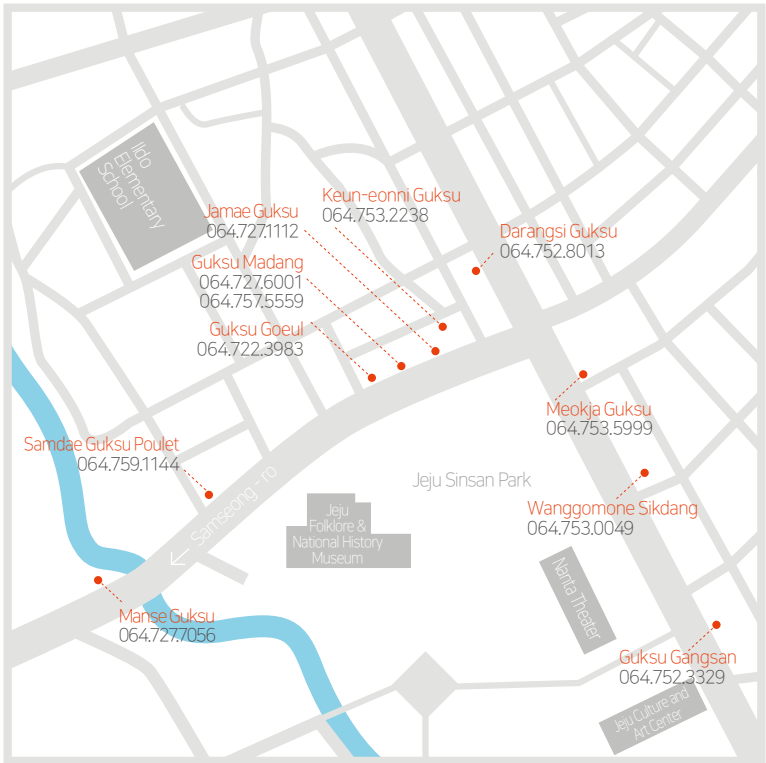
What dishes represent the flavor of Jeju Island? Different people will recommend different dishes. If you ask the average Jeju person to recommend a dish that they enjoy the most, many of them will consider "gogi-guksu" their first choice. Gogiguksu refers to noodles in a meat soup. Of course, you can find similar dishes in other areas of Korea. But Jeju's gogi-guksu noodles are different. First, the pig bones are boiled for a long time until the soup is a milky color. Traditionally, pork has been the most favored meat on the island. Among all types of dishes developed using pork, the bone soup has been preferred for its simple taste and because it could fill up many hungry stomachs when, in the past, food was not abundant. Well-boiled flour noodles topped with boiled pork slices are served in a bowl of the soup. This is gogi-guksu. The noodles, not too thick or thin served in a generous quantity, and are plenty to fill the hungry stomach of an adult. It is a local specialty that has satisfied the native taste of the Jeju people for a long time.

### Guksu Geori (Noodle Street)

Many gogi-guksu restaurants stand in a row on Ido-dong street in the mideastern part of Jeju-si. The popularity of gogi-guksu has become part of Jeju culture. They are open early in the morning until late at night, attracting locals and tourists day and night.

#### HOW TO ENJOY GOGI-GUKSU (NOODLE SOUP)

- ✓ At the core is the tasty bone soup. Use the crushed (or sliced) dry seaweed as topping only for mueolchi-guksu (Noodles in Dry Anchovy Soup).
- ✓ Do not add the spicy paste unless you want your noodles to be very spicy. The boiled pork slices are tastier if you eat them with the dipping sauce (seasoned bean paste).
- ✓ Green peppers and sliced raw onions are also good with the same dipping sauce.

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## BLACK PORK STREET

### Jeju Pork - Superb Quality and Taste

When people think about food from Jeju, the black pig comes to mind. Called "heuk-dwaeji", literally meaning "black pig", the animal is native to Jeju. As the name indicates, the pig's skin is covered with black hair. Traditional Jeju houses had a pigsty in close proximity to the main house building. The pigs were fed with leftovers. When there was a party in the village, the homegrown pigs were shared among the people by grilling or boiling them. Houses on Jeju no longer raise pigs and they are now raised in commercial farms. Although the farmers raise a lot of improved varieties, Jeju people's love for Jeju's black pigs has not changed. The climate and the soil of Jeju Island are good for raising the black pigs. For this reason, the quality and taste of the meat from Jeju's heuk-dwaeji, or black pigs, are truly superb.

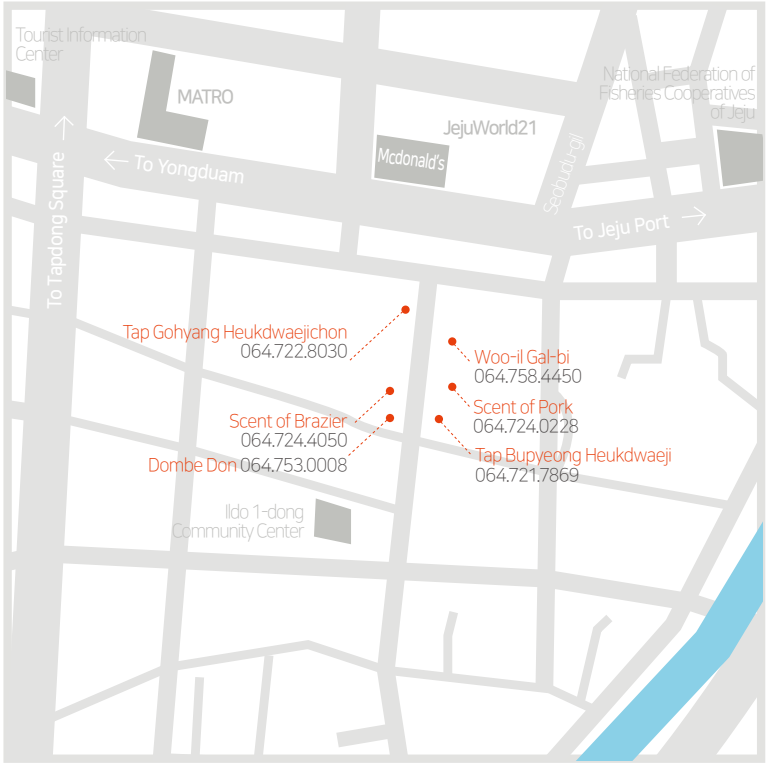
The owners of pork restaurants on this street guarantee that they sell only Jeju's black pig meat. Visitors do not have to worry about being served with a non-Jeju product.

IS IT SAMGYEOPSA (3-LAYERED PORK STRIPS)?

OR OGYEOPSA (5-LAYERED PORK STRIPS)?

Samgyeopsal (3-layered pork strips) is the most favored cut of pork by Koreans. Samgyeopsal refers to the meat in the area near the ribs. The meat was named as such because that part of the meat has three layers between fat and meat. ogyeopsal is preferred more by the Jeju people. It is actually samgyeopsal with two more layers, including the skin and the layer right under the skin. People on Jeju enjoy the extra chewy texture of ogyeopsal.

### Seafood for All Seasons

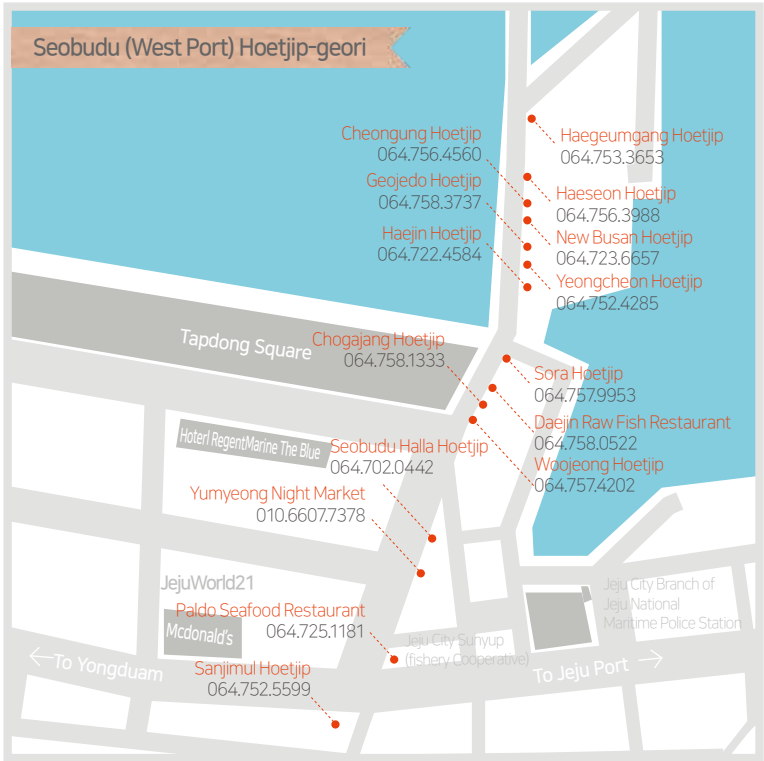
In the dark night, the waters of Jeju are brightly lit like Christmas, as Jeju fishermen turn on the lights on their boats to attract fish all through the night. Fishermen supply various kinds of fish to the market, such as yellowtail fish, sea bream, hairtail fish, mackerel, whitesaddled reef fish (coralfish), yellow porgy (yellow sea bream), saw-edged perch, horse mackerel (yellowfin horse mackerel), brown seaweed, spear squid, sea urchin, abalone, and many more. You can eat just about any type of seafood you'd like on Jeju. The clean sea of Jeju harbors all types of fish species all year around. Seafood restaurants serving a wide variety of fresh fish can be found all over the island. Seobudo (West Port) Pier is especially well-known as "Hoetjip (Raw Fish Restaurant) Street", where you can find many raw fish eateries open side by side along the pier.

### Seobudu (West Port) Hoetjip-geori (Raw Fish Restaurant Street)

Many raw fish restaurants are open side by side along the Seobudu (West Port) Pier. When you order raw fish as the main dish, a number of side dishes are served for free. At the end of the course, either spicy fish soup or fish porridge is also served.

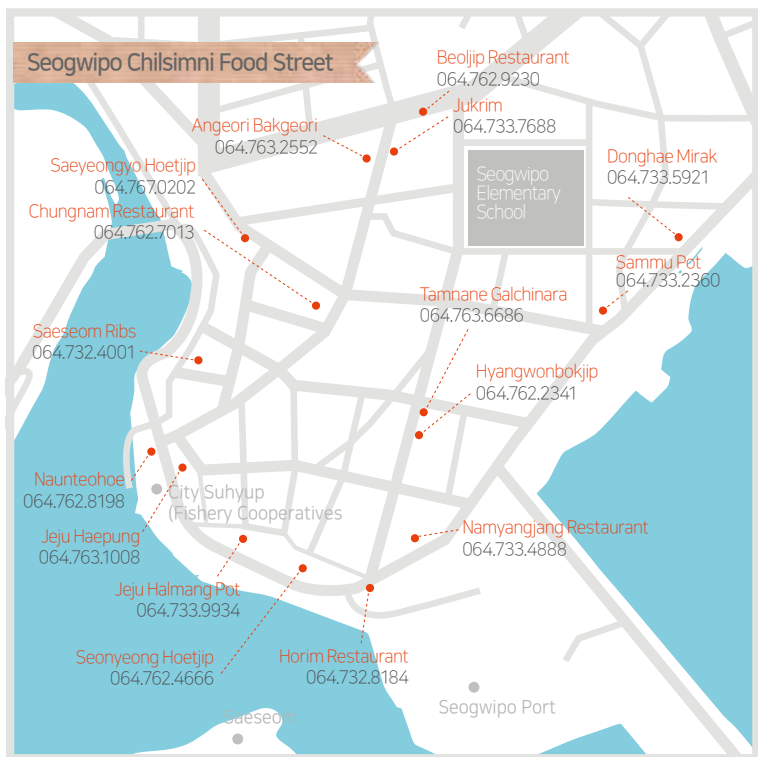
## Nutritious Meat

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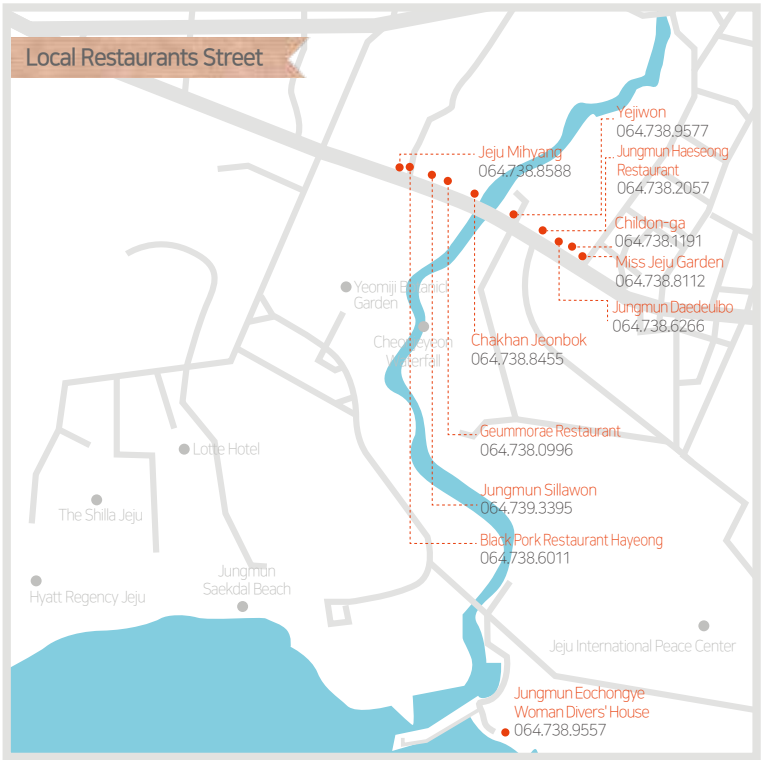

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## Sweet Fragrance of Jeju's Tangerines

Tangerines are the representative fruit of Jeju Island and are popular among Koreans for its taste, texture, and price. Jeju produces different variants of tangerines fruit all year around. Visitors can easily find tangerine orchards with yellow tangerines hanging on the trees all around. Various products have been developed using tangerines, such as chocolate, juice, ice cream, perfume, and many more. Autumn is the main season for tangerine harvesting on Jeju. There are many tour programs or events that offer tourists a chance to visit a tangerine orchard and experience picking tangerines fruit from trees. Premium variants such as, Cheonhyehyang and Hallabong, are popular souvenirs because of their sweet taste and fragrance.

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## Tangerines, a Natural Cold Medicine

Tangerines, containing a treasure of vitamins, is natural and nutritious and helps people stay healthy in winter. With 100g of tangerines containing 36mg of vitamin C, the vitamin content in two tangerines more than satisfy the required amount for an adult (50mg per day). As beta-carotene is absorbed in the body, it changes to vitamin A which engages in physiological processes, such as improvement of sexual performance and immune reactions, and reproduction of epithelial cells.

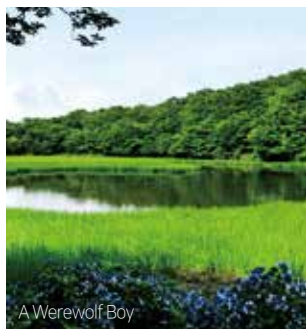

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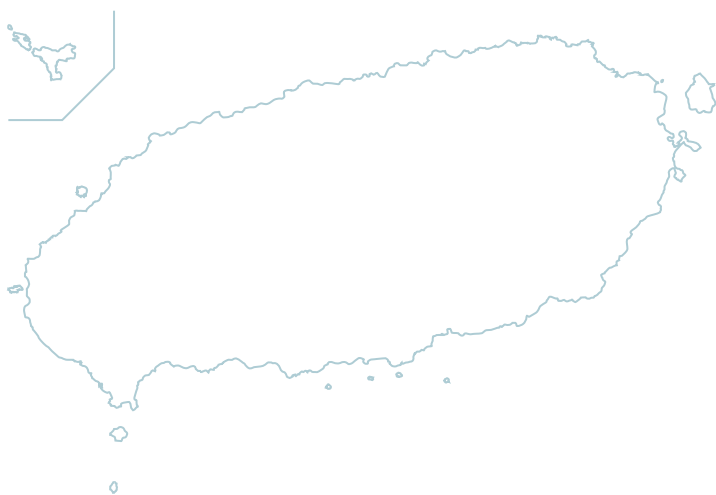
